### Old Business:

**Phase II Remodeling Project** – Currently this project is approximately half way completed. The sidewalks have been raised approximately 5 inches which has eliminated pondage. Nonster is waiting for the brickwork to cure and then will proceed with finishing the entry steps.

**Front Sign** – Council continues to get bids together to upgrade the front sign.

**AED** – Council is in the process of installing an AED from the Greg Holthaus Memorial Fund. A member of the Greg Holthaus Memorial Fund will be at the next monthly council meeting to give us more information.

**Decommissioning Service** – July 8 will be the decommissioning service with Rev. Shana Johnson in attendance. There will be an appetizer fellowship luncheon/open house following the service.
